Supplies

Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™
12x12 cardstocks

- 1 sheet Royal Complements® Umber, Snowcrest Embossed
- 1 sheet Classics Paprika
- 1 sheet Royal Fiber® Tuscan Sun, Bark Embossed
- 1 sheet Royal Complements® Citron, Snowcrest Embossed
- 1 sheet Royal Fiber® Sunflower, Bark Embossed

Fiskars® Leaf Border Punch

EK Success® Mini Leaf punch

Paper Trimmer

Scissors

Therm O Web® Super Tape 1/4" and
Memory Tape Runner XL

Liquid glue

Instructions

1. Cut a 2"x6" piece of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Paprika cardstock.
2. Use the Leaf border punch to punch the pattern on both long sides of the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Paprika cardstock.
3. Cut a 3/4"x6" strip of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Umber cardstock using the Paper trimmer. Attach this to the punched border piece in the center using Memory Tape Runner.
4. Punch out several leaves using a leaf punch and Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Citron, Sunflower, and Tuscan Sun cardstocks.
5. Use liquid glue to attach the punched leaves to the punched border piece centering them on the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Umber cardstock.
6. Attach the napkin ring around a napkin using super tape to fasten. The finished rings will fit much better if they are wrapped around the napkin and then sized accordingly.
